Saint Paul was well aware of this: he had persecuted the Church, calling himself 'the greatest of sinners' and yet, thanks to the inexhaustible patience of God, he can count himself a believer. We must be open to the gift of forgiveness for ourselves, and also (as the Parable of the Elder Brother shows) open to that forgiveness offered to others, whom we would condemn.
